- 2 letters of recommendation. One letter must be from a high school teacher and one from a member of one of the community service providers. The person making the recommendation must be 21 years of age or older and cannot be from a family member.
- Total household “adjusted gross income” as reported on the 2 previous year’s federal tax returns (or would have been reported if a federal tax return was not filed).
- Statement from parent or guardian stipulating that the household’s financial condition has not material changed since the last calendar year, or if it has changed the statement must describe how it has changed.
- A statement indicating that the applicant is not affiliated with, nor is an immediate family member of, any officer, trustee, member of the HK Community Scholarship Committee, or any individual who has contributed \$5,000 or more to HK Community Fund, Inc.
